Golden Wedding Service at Ripon Cathedral

For many years Ripon Cathedral has held a service for couples who are celebrating 50 years or more of marriage. The couples are invited to apply for free tickets for themselves, family and friends.

This June, 74 couples attended (one was celebrating 70 years of marriage!). This year three couples from St Giles: Sara and Nick Leefe, Audrey and Jim Harrison and Sue and Ken Ball attended the ceremony. Previous years have seen other members of St Giles attend the service.

On this occasion the service was led by the Very Rev John Dobson, Dean of Ripon and the service was sung by the

Boy Choristers and Lay Clerks of the Cathedral choir with the Right Reverend Toby Howarth, Bishop of Bradford giving the sermon. The two Bible readings related to marriage. The first reading, read by one of the Golden Wedding celebrants, was from the first letter of St John and was about love - which was mentioned 13 times in the short passage. The second reading, read by Brigadier Nigel Ward, was from the Gospel of St

John about the wedding in Cana of Galilee. The choir sang John Rutter's anthem "*The Lord bless you and keep you.*"

Hymns included "*Praise, My Soul, the King of Heaven*", "*Lead us Heavenly Father Lead us*" and "*Love Divine, all loves excelling*". Each "bride" was presented with a golden carnation buttonhole and the grand finale was the Organ Voluntary Toccata (Symphony number 5) which rang

through the rafters of Ripon Cathedral. The St Giles' representatives thoroughly enjoyed the service, which was followed by tea and cakes.

Attendees received a beautifully presented

Golden Wedding Service pamphlet, at the back of which was a message from the Queen's Private Secretary. The Queen sent her congratulations and best wishes to all those participating in the event and hoped it was a most memorable and enjoyable occasion. Indeed, it was a great afternoon and one which is definitely worthy of attending.

Getting to know...



PETER & HAZEL SMITH

Peter (1935) and Hazel Smith (1937) were both born in Headingley and educated at local schools, including Quarry Mount in Hyde Park (not London).

Hazel trained as a secretary at Pitman's College, worked for the Prudential and helped Peter on the administrative side of his building company. Peter trained as an apprentice builder by day and on three evenings per week attended night school. Peter set up his own company when he left the RAF in 1957, having fought bravely for Britain for two years. Peter initially employed 13 people in the building trade, subsequently focusing on buying and converting property, a job from which he has only just "retired".

They fell in love in 1957, since when everything went downhill! They married in 1959, living in Cookridge for 23 years before moving to Bramhope in 1988. This latter and very successful move was



instigated by the then St Giles's vicar, Reverend Raymond Ward, who ignited their interests in the benefits of Bramhope and St Giles Church.

Andrew was born in 1961; unfortunately their three-month-old baby Jeremy died with spina bifida in 1963. Paula, 20 minutes older and Clare arrived on the scene as non-identical twins in 1964. Peter Andrew was born in 1982 and they have 7 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren

From an early age, both have had a strong faith. Peter has sung in the choir since the age of five years, even before he could read. One of Peter's early churches was St Margaret's on Cardigan Road - now a community centre - where he was both chorister and carried the hand held holder for the incense.

Both have been very active on the voluntary front. Peter was a JP from 1982 - 2005, and he founded the ABC (Adel, Bramhope & Cookridge) club in 1994 which has raised just short of £40,000 for good causes. Peter has also been strongly supportive of the Royal Society of St George, a society open to anyone who loves England and supports the society's aims and objects which all relate to everything that maintains a good English way of life. Peter has been President of the society and of Leeds Probus society. You must never upset Peter. Why? He won his black belt in judo in 1967, and for several years, was a judo instructor for the police and other organisations.

Hazel's contributions to the NSPCC are legendary, especially with her twice yearly fundraising events, now fondly called "Hazel's NSPCC fundraising coffee mornings". More about this in subsequent St Giles magazines... Both support "Caring for Life."

Both are great company to be in; Hazel's jokes outclass many of the stand-up comedians. Hopefully they will celebrate their diamond wedding anniversary next year. Peter has promised Hazel a little diamond, to which Hazel responds who said anything about "little". Peter is also a very good raconteur, not just at church social events, but during services if the moment is appropriate.

We are reliably informed that Peter has requested at his funeral the national anthem at which he hopes to rise to the occasion, along with one of Ken Dodd's familiar songs "I thank the Lord that I've been blessed with more than my share of happiness". A very good Christian thought.

The Transfiguration of Christ

On August 6, the Church celebrates the Transfiguration of Christ. Mark's Gospel (Chapter 9 Verses 2-12) tells us that Jesus takes Peter, James and John up a high mountain where he is transfigured before them and his clothes became "dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them and there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking to Jesus...Then a cloud appeared and enveloped them and a voice came from the cloud: ' This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him' ".

On one level, the Transfiguration asks us to be shining examples of our faith journey. We do say that some people are shining people.

But speaking of the Transfiguration, the writer Henri Nouwen tells this true story: A Franciscan climbed into the pulpit at Strasbourg Cathedral and spoke about the Transfiguration of Jesus and of all creation. As he spoke he pointed to the brilliant

yellow, white and blue rose window above the cathedral entrance.

He said, "Though this is a great piece of art, we can only see its splendour when the light shines through it".

He then explained how our bodies, the works of our hands, and all that exists can shine with splendour only when we let God's light shine through them.
